Why are you processing my personal information?

Do you transfer my personal data to other countries?

We will not transfer your personal data to any other country.

How long do you keep my personal data?

Data that is inputted via the Snap website is held in backup for fourteen weeks after closure of the survey and AFBI deleting it from the webhost account.

Once the project is completed, AFBI will anonymise the data were possible, but reserves the right to retain your personal data indefinitely for long-term research or statistical purposes under the derogations contained within Schedule 2, Part 6 of the UK Data Protection Act 2018. Where this is the case, appropriate technical and organisational measures will be in place to ensure the security of your data and respect for your privacy.

What rights do I have?
