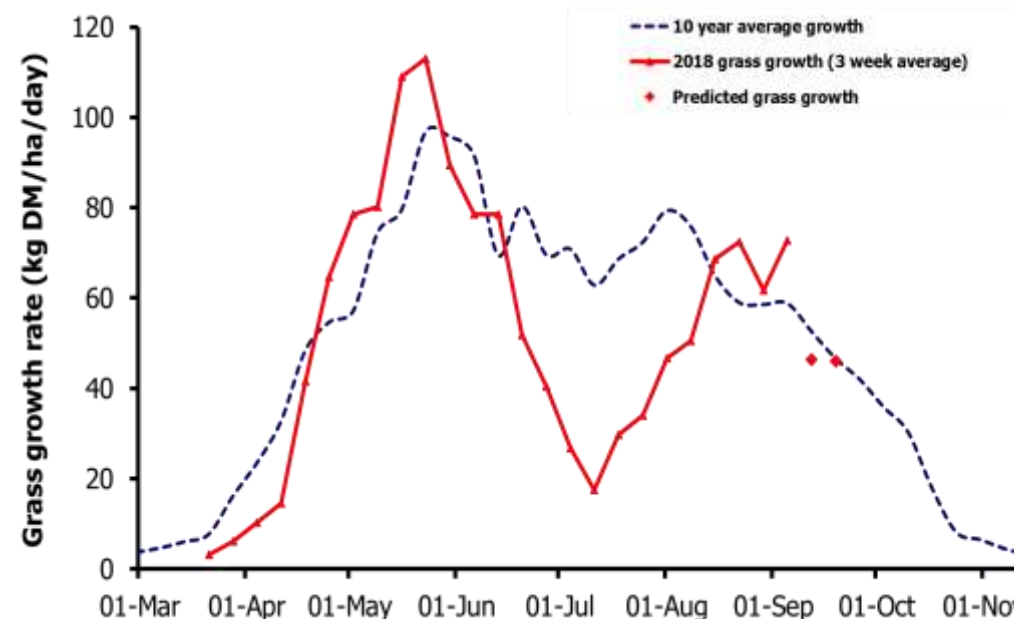
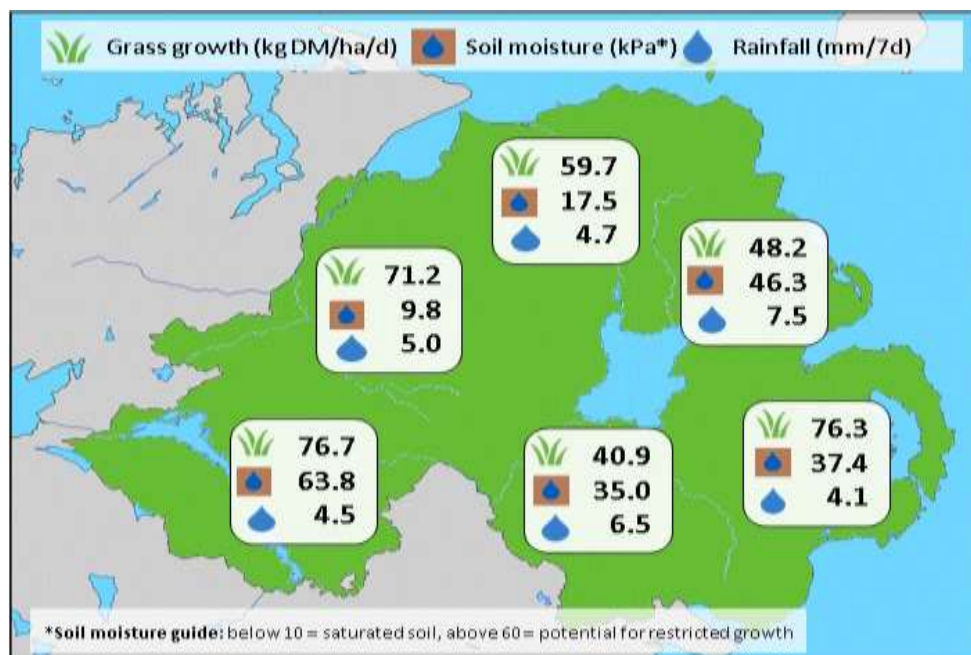


## Week Beginning 3 September 2018



### MANAGEMENT NOTES:

- Total growth over the summer period was reduced 28.1% on the GrassCheck plots however this past week growth rates have remained well above average as warm conditions prevail.
- With good growth conditions still evident, response to nitrogen fertiliser remains strong. Any chemical fertiliser applications must be complete before 15 September.
- With shortening day lengths, grass quality has reduced to 13.7% DM and 10.8 MJ/kg DM. Factor grass quality results into feed plans and maintenance-plus calculations to maintain good animal performance.
